Windham's November Election Results: State Rep

Candidate	11/3/20	11/12/20	Difference	% Change

Every Republican candidate on election night was short by nearly 300 votes
Democrat candidate Kristi St. Laurent was awarded 99 more votes than cast.
The margin of St. Laurent's loss went from 24 votes (.005%) to 420 votes (9.6%).

Some interesting observations...

IN PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION YEARS:

- - President usually gets most votes
- Down-ballot drop-off in votes

IN ARIZONA THIS ELECTION:

- Unusual that Mark Kelly (Dem. Candidate for Senate) got 102% of Biden vote
- In NH, Jeanne Shaheen got **106%** of Biden vote!



More interesting observations...

Jeanne Shaheen received more votes than any candidate for federal (DC) office in the history of NH!

- 70,000 more votes than Obama in 2008
- 100,000 more votes than she received in 2008 (her first Senate run)
- 200,000 more votes than in 2014!!

Where did all of these votes come from???



More interesting observations...

3 COUNTIES WHERE THE JEANNE SHAHEEN VOTE INCREASED THE MOST:

- 1) Rockingham: + 96.20%
- 2) Hillsborough: + 92.14%
- 3) Strafford: + 87.33%

WITHIN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY:

- 1) Derry: + 106% (flipped from Rep. to Dem.)
- 2) Hampton Falls: + 119% (flipped from Rep. to Dem.)
- 3) Londonderry: + 124% (flipped from Rep. to Dem.)
- 4) But, **the one town in Rockingham county that had the greatest increase in votes** for Jeanne Shaheen compared to 2014, was...



WINDHAM!!!

130% increase in votes compared to 2014!

2014: 2,061 votes

2020: 4,738 votes (+ 2,677)

From a town that votes Republican 60% of the time?!?

The Facts

- There is an unexplained discrepancy between the machine count and the hand recount
- The recount resulted in an increase of 6% for Republicans and a loss of over 2% for the Democrat
- NH has NEVER seen a discrepancy of this magnitude before
- Neither the Secretary of State nor the Attorney General have shown any initiative or desire to investigate this historic discrepancy
- The AG's office has refused to investigate either the ballots or the machines
- The SOS and Sen. Jim Gray have attempted to justify their lack of scrutiny – “It didn’t change the outcome of the election.”



Some opinions...

- This is NOT a partisan issue. ***We The People*** must be able to trust our elections.
- ***We The People*** are not allowed by law to examine these ballots and machines ourselves
- ***We The People*** should demand that no machine counting of votes ever be used again in the State of New Hampshire



Bigger concerns about election integrity

- Many of the numbers from official election results seem *highly unlikely* and deserve greater scrutiny
- Those are important. However, we should all be focused on Windham right now...
- In Windham, there is a clear, undeniable discrepancy which has never been explained. We need to know why it happened
- For right now, we urge you to focus your efforts on the Windham.
- If successful in getting results on Windham, we may have a stronger basis for demanding further investigation elsewhere.
